#### Financial Update - Leanna Staben

- Budget has been updated per what we voted on in the last meeting
- Direct donations received for September is 73.327.59
- Received money for misc fundraisers like amazon smile (no cost fundraising)
- Paid expenses from direct donations credit card fees and software, directory spot and PTO newsletter

#### Fundraising Update - Julia Swenson

- Direct Donations are at 110K so far. We are behind then where we were this time in past years
- 89 Families have donated. This time in 2019 we had 112 families and in 2018 we had 140 families
- Low numbers due to not being on campus this year. This causes low engagement

- we're communicating about Direct Donations through the thunderbolt, room parents, and fliers in distribution packets for K-4.

#### Programs / Enrichment Update - Heidi Von Briel

- Garden and Science classes are ongoing
- There were some issues with the garden videos but Jessica Kwa has helped to resolve it
- Science from scientists has delivered kits to 4th graders and started classes. They met with the 5th grade and are working on what to do for their class
- Spanish enrichment has started for 6th to 8th grade since the enrichments are not happening this trimester
- They have signed a contract to complete 2 hours a week. There is a slight lag between time spent and the report. The feedback so far is good
- James henry has shared his 5 videos and the teachers will be sharing them soon with their classes

#### Q & A

- When will schools be reopening? The school site council is working on this with Diane. Diane stated that per the board meeting last week, they are planning January 19 as the open date. On Wednesday, October 21 at the next RCSD Board Meeting they will discuss further the different scenarios and guidelines. There are four pillars to reopening. Mr. Baker will give them specific guidelines. Diane will work with the teachers to discuss options and bring their ideas back to the school site council to vote on.
- How do you sign up for Spanish? Spanish is currently full. There were 36 students that applied and they allowed 32 to join the program. There are 4 students on the waiting list if any of the 32 drop the program. They are no longer taking applications. This is being tested this year and if it's successful, they may expand it next year
- Will there be a school wide activity for Halloween this year? They're talking about bringing back spirit days. They may have parents send in photos of their child in their costume but it would be managed through teachers / room parents and not school wide.
