PTO Meeting Summary Tuesday, March 09, 2021

Call Meeting to Order / Meeting Norms / Introductions / Acknowledgements - Ryan Flynn

- The PTO meeting started at 7:02 pm virtually via Zoom 215 attendees
- No questions received prior to meeting
- Parent survey coming out on programs for next year
- SEL March 18th from 4 to 5pm Kindness Campaign: Parents and children 4th 8 grade can attend
- April meeting we will present several PTO Officer openings
- Discuss and vote on by-law amendment in April meeting

Fundraising: Jog-a-thon Update - Julia Swenson

- This is the last fundraising event of the year
- Design contest for T-shirt there will be a google form to vote on a winner
- Week long event from home
- Whole family can participate

Reopening Discussion - Parent Q&A - Diane Prystas and Kristy Jackson

- We are only going to cover what Roy Cloud is going to do. We are excited to return in person as the tiers have changed. We are looking at how to move forward with reopening plans.
 There has been a fast track since Gov Neusom made the announcement that all schools should open by April 1st. We are reviewing the plans with Dr. Baker and there will be a district meeting tomorrow at 7pm. We are focusing on K-5 and middle school. All teachers are getting vaccinated.
- There are a lot of unknowns but will update as we know more need to have an idea of who is coming back to make arrangements
- Need to know the number of students coming back per grade level
- Majority of teachers will be coming back
- K-5 is looking at an AM / PM model students come to school 2 2.5 hours a day
- Parents are required to finish the minimum learning time
- Weds will stay async kids on campus 4 days per week
- There will be 45 mins in between for teacher lunch / sanitize
- Schedule depends on how many come back only half responded to survey so far
- 90% want to return from surveys received
- Middle school possibly cohorts by subject blocks
- Gov giving districts lots of money to return to school
- Not all teachers will be fully vaccinated by the return to school
- March 22nd grade levels will come for 1 ½ hours for new guidelines rotating in groups of 15
- Teachers first day in class is April 8th
- Don't know the air filter flow rate but it has been approved by the county office. There is brand new air filtration and portable to circulate air
- Windows and doors will be open and portable filters

- Teachers are given a choice to return
- Assign specific grades to specific parking lots areas for temp check, then proceed to campus
- Should have a teacher name and schedule to send out by the 15th to all students. Trying to accommodate staying with your same teacher but can't do it for every request
- Max is 15 in a hub
- Tomorrow teachers are cleaning up the classrooms to make more room
- Desk in AM group not used for PM group
- Trying to prioritize same family on same schedule
- Can't have changing decision on in person or distance
- Safety protocols Need to wear a mask including drivers for drop off, take temp before out of
 car, Fill out a daily consent form, bring own equipment, bring water bottle, be on time for pick
 up / drop off, specific route to classroom, 6 feet apart at all times, teacher will walk them in to
 class, assigned seats, kinder will have marks on carpet, only certain box of toys used per
 group, wear mask at all times, extra masks with you, can take off only to eat snack, designated
 zones to play that Legarza coach will enforce, wash and sanitize hands before returning to
 class
- Not sure if families can choose am or pm
- Accelerated math will be part of the planning
- Not sure of middle school schedule yet
- District is providing PPE supplies
- Will try to work with PPC and kids corner as much as we can
- Reaching out to kinder separately as not to confuse them
- May staggers arrivals and departures
- They will go to school and do async from home rest of day
- Can't do full days as limit per hub is 15 and can't all fit in class 6 feet
- Survey deadline is tonight
- Most teachers want to return and are excited to be back with kids
- Middle school is concerned about fitting all curriculum in as time is limited
- Distant learners should have the same teacher
- Trimester 3 will not have enrichments
- For spring break CDC suggests no travel and guarantine if you do
- Will not have plexiglass on desk
- Students will be distant learning until April 8th
- Not sure if childcare is offered before class need to check with your provider
- Not possible to postpone conferences as they have already been scheduled
- Will offer covid tests if they want them but it won't be mandatory
- Staff testing is mandatory for covid
- There will be walking areas designated for students walking to school tents will be set for them
- If the student has a fever, they will be sent to the infirmary and parents will be called to come get them asap
- If they get a fever during the day they will be sent to the infirmary to isolate them from others until picked up by parents
- Not enforcing double masks
- Legarza goes back to sports camp after lunch and can't provide childcare
- Legarza coaches help with arrivals and departures
- Rainy day line up outside classroom and stay 6 feet apart
- MUB is not available

- If there is a positive test class would have to quarantine for 72 hours
- Anna and Charlene will follow up on surveys not received tomorrow
- We are following the county and district guidelines
- Questions will be captured and will put them up on the site asap as well as the recording
