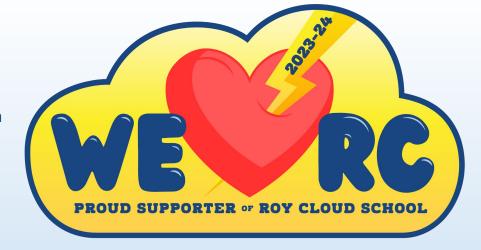

 - Fund programs previously paid for by the state

 - Fund critical services
 - Support teachers and administration

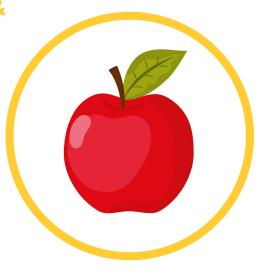

Library & Literacy FAN Update

- 2023 Auction raised \$32,800 for a 2023-24 Fund-a-Need initiative
- Books in the Collection: 11,483 to 11,840
- Average Publication Age: 2007 to 2010
- Book-Student Ratio: Current =17:1; Ideal = 25:1
- Have spent about \$14,000 to date
 - Books ordered from ABDO and Follett (\$12,000)
 - → Signage/displays from Demco (\$1300)
 - BookBreak Fall 2023 Virtual Author Visits (\$975)
- Plans for rest of the 2023-24 school year
 - More books and author events!
 - Read Across America activities in March
 - Board games, art supplies and free standing display table







Budget Updates



2023-2024 Budget Updates

Key changes relative to May 2023 voted & approved budget:

- Physical education (TK 5) \$50K ⇒ \$18K
- Science enrichment \$20K → \$46K

 Science from Scientists (grades 3-8) ↑ costs and added \$10K for TK-2 science programs like LHS, MSI, etc.
- Garden support \$1K → \$21K

 Planned infrastructure upgrades: shade, seating, irrigation, rot replacement, potential expansion, cleanup, etc.
- Counseling Services (MTSS) \$12K
- Makerspace Support \$10K
 Upgrading STEAM equipment, materials, and technology
- Social emotional learning \$10K
 Created dedicated line item for SEL program as the 2019 "fund-a-need" fund will deplete
