Budget Updates



2024-2025 Budget Updates

Key proposed changes to May 2024 voted & approved budget:

- Carry forward balance: \$363,925 → \$334,435
 Total combined accounts balance carried over to new school year
- Income: Direct Donations \$250K ⇒ \$260K
- Art Program \$42K → \$30,215
 Contract negotiated to lesser amount and added 2K for art show supplies
- Beautification \$2K
 Adding funds for campus improvements not covered by the 2024 FAN
- Equipment and Technology \$25,860 → \$30K

 Adding funds for damaged class tvs and chromebooks
- Music Enrichment \$62K → \$59,076
 FT music instructor received 20% coverage by CTA, ↓ PTO contribution; added Music for Minors TK-K music lessons
- Science Enrichment \$46K → \$31K
 Science from Scientists (adjusted for grades 3-6) and added \$6K for TK-2 science (NEW!)
