Direct Donations Campaign Update	 Direct donations campaign is officially over, but donations are welcome throughout the year Tally as of today is \$245k We have hit our budgeted goal, but our campaign goal is higher We hope to get our participation numbers into the 50%'s We'll make a push on Giving Week There's a party for the grade with the highest participation There was a tie between TK and 2nd grade, but we're waiting for final matching numbers to determine the winner
Budget Check In	Highlights: ■ Leanna has filed taxes for 23-24

She's been at Roy Cloud for ~5 years, 4th year at this position. Engages students in both classroom settings and small group sessions. Students eventually graduate out of the program. • K-2 uses Haggerty program for reading • Daily Activities and Parent Communication • Classroom and small group sessions throughout the week • Frequent communication with parents Books sent home for extra practice Scheduled small group sessions daily for targeted support English Language Support for Emerging Multilingual Learners Designated English Language support throughout the day Daily support during 8th period

	 Assists 4th-5th Elementary and Middle School students in diverse settings Collaboration and Consultation with Teachers Provides guidance on best practices in reading and language instruction Assists with Student Support Team (SST) and 504 plans and meetings Guides teachers on reading assessments and reviews results together Supporting Roy Cloud Staff and Professional Development Leads Small Group Professional Development Leads Small Group Professional Learning Community for instructional best practices, focusing on small group instruction Substitutes in TK-8 when needed Supports professional growth among teaching staff, specifically with district initiatives Student Support and Assessment 50-100 reading intervention students supported weekly Students phase in and out as students make progress 21-30 Emerging Multilingual students supported weekly Administers ELPAC testing Helps plans and attends SST and IEP meetings Additional Responsibilities Provides support to new students and multilingual learners on the playground Fosters a welcoming environment for all newcomers at Roy Cloud Supports students feeling successful and achieving their goals A Comprehensive Approach to Student Success Emphasizes the importance of holistic and targeted intervention Highlights commitment to family engagement and teacher collaboration Reiterates dedication to student achievement in both reading and English language skills
