- Still waiting on district invoice which mostly covers expenses for PTO funded staff positions

## Potential Parcel Tax Initiative

Budget cuts happening - every school is trying to figure out what to do.

Federal Funding for schools over the next few years is also at risk.

Districts in the Bay Area rely on parcel taxes as a significant source of funding. Parcel Taxes need to be approved by affected voters via ballot.

Parcel Tax Ballots submitted by **public entities** require a 2/3rds majority.

- Measure S (<u>Nov/2022</u> bond 55%) YES: 17,895 60.42% NO: 11,721 39.58%
- Measure H (<u>Nov/2019</u> parcel tax 2/3rd) YES: 10,886 66.22% (66.67% required) Total votes: 16,457 / voting population: 51,047 - failed by ~72 votes
- Measure U (<u>Nov/2016</u> parcel tax 2/3rd) YES: 30,053 79.80% NO: 7,602 20.20%

Parcel Tax Ballots submitted by citizens - as a citizen initiative - require 50% + 1.

Let's get a citizen initiative on the next ballot! To support our schools! But... We need to raise money, we need help collecting signatures, we need help with social media, campaigning, legal, ...

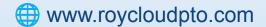
