| Parcel Tax Initiative | A group of parents is organizing to put a parcel tax on the ballot for the district as a Citizen's Initiative . |

| | Summary: |
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| | Budget cuts happening - every school is trying to figure out what to do. Districts in the Bay Area rely on parcel taxes as a significant source of funding. Parcel Taxes need to be approved by affected voters via ballot. Parcel Tax Ballots submitted by the district require a 2/3rds majority Previously, Measure U passed in 2016 with 79% but Measure H failed in 2019 with 66.2% (by ~72 votes) However, Parcel Tax Ballots submitted by citizens - as a citizen initiative - only require 50% + 1 Call for participation from parents: We need to raise money, we need help collecting signatures, we need help with social media, campaigning, legal, There are monthly meetings for those involved in the effort, and all are welcome To participate or ask any questions, please email Ben Packer (bpacker@qmail.com) or Jessica Shade (jesshade@gmail.com) |
| Message from the Principal | Discussion of the Mental Health Counseling Program at Roy Cloud Mrs. Julia Robinson is Roy Cloud's counselor 7th year at Roy Cloud, and has been an incredible resource for our students Tier 1: whole school Grades 3-8 complete a weekly mental health check-in form This includes an option to request a check-in: there are on average 13 check-in requests per week Drop-in conflict resolution Drop-ins are at slightly higher volume than requests via the form Parents and caregivers can submit a counseling request via Tier 2: Individual counseling: 6-10 1:1 weekly sessions of 25-30 min Group counseling: 6-10 25-30 min sessions with 2-5 students Tier 3: crisis risk assessment An evaluation is done through this program, though in cases where severe interventions are required there is an external referral |
