- Phase 1 work is considered to be a “Light Touch” to increase security.
- Timeline: State 4-6 months for approval. Open Bid 1-2 months.
- Measure T Bond, completion of the entire project, July 2021

- SCOPE OF WORK:
- FRONT - Red Oak, 6 Ft Black Cast Ornamental fence to follow along the curb of the front parking lot from School Office to Library, button activated gates with push-bar exit.
- REAR - Jefferson, 6 Ft Chain Link fence spanning the entire perimeter of the playground and rear parking lot, button activated gates with push-bar exit (similar to current fencing).
- Walk In Cooler added to the Multi Use Building
- Bathrooms updated for ADA compliance
- The RCSD has held informative gatherings throughout the district.
