School wide Goals and Programs for our students

- TOSA - Teacher On Special Assignment  
This teacher would champion our staff to use their personal strengths to teach technology. Each teacher, in each grade level, would be specifically chosen to teach a small part of a larger learning experience, this is known as building block learning.
- 50% of Measure U Funds were approved through site council to fund TOSA
- This role will replace our Technology Coach
- Salary has been approved for, \$65,000
- "Innovative Space" will set up potentially in one of our current portables

- This space will launch “low tech” and offer our students a place to, create, explore, and learn the fundamentals of technology
- Discussion:
  - These technology programs are not stable and come-and-go with no long term consistency for all students.
