Bond Construction Update - Don Dias, RCSD Bond Program Director, Mark Casini, Project Manager, Brent McNlure, Architect

- Presentation made by project architectural firm, CAW
  - Replacement of door hardware
  - Replace classroom countertop and sinks, ADA compliant
  - Replacing all classrooms doors
  - Renovating all bathrooms to ADA compliance
  - MUB Kitchen will receive a new walk in cooler
  - Fencing will surround the entire campus
  - Iron Picketing fencing will go around the front of the school and parking area
  - Behind the school, Jefferson Avenue will include 2 pedestrian gates, one being ADA compliant.
  - Paint schemes were created with the schools Administration
  - Project scheduled to begin in May 2020
  - Construction will work around Summer School
  - We are still waiting on approval of this work from the state of CA
  - At this time local districts can chose if bathrooms will be gender or gender specific
  - Summer school will be hosted at Roy Cloud,
  - The campus will only be locked down during school hours
  - Cameras will be installed around the campus to protect against vandalism
  - Only the exterior will be painted
  - The fencing around the campus will be consistent
  - Only the students restrooms will be renovated, none of the adult bathrooms
  - There will be no furniture in the first phase of this project
  - Additional exterior lighting can be brought out form the district for night events
  - Sewerline will not be replaced, an alarm has been set on it in case of backup
  - Prop 13 Bond is a statewide school bond that may never reach the RCSD
