- The PTO meeting started at 7:01 pm virtually via Zoom
- No questions received prior to meeting

Fundraising: Jog-a-thon Update - Julia Swenson

- T-shirt sales and pledge kicked off today
- Amazing volunteer team that have put in a lot of work
- Jog-a-thon runs May 17 - 23
- Each student will receive a step counter prior to event
- Can use your own device but still need to provide proof of the steps completed if you win
- Students will enter steps on a google slide
- Winners will need to provide picture of their steps as proof
- There will also be a scavenger hunt along the walking school route. Words will be painted on rocks and if completed they will be entered in a raffle to win a prize
- T-shirt will be available for pick up the week of May 3rd
- Goal is 25,000 this year and would love to exceed it

Bylaws Amendment - Alex Dendy

- Proposed bylaw amendment
- There is a tight timeframe for officer elections this year
- Elections will be introduced in the Thunderbolt instead of a separate meeting
- In the last PTO meeting - New officers will be introduced
- Current - Elections will be held by the week of the last meeting of the school year but may occur the week of the second to last meeting of the school year if the Nominating Committee **is able to present at a meeting** held at least fourteen (14) days prior
- Proposed - Elections will be held by the week of the last meeting of the school year but may occur the week of the second to last meeting of the school year if the Nominating Committee **distributes a notice in a written publication regularly issued or distributed to students of the school at least seven (7) days prior**

2021-22 Budget Discussion & Vote - Leanna Staben and Jim Balesteri

- We have all items for next year accounted for in the budget
- Need to keep a close eye on money we have and what we have to spend as there is not a lot of carry over from previous years
- Will have a one time only Cares help to alleviate the budget
- Money raised this year applies to next year
- K-2 will be reduced 25 to 1
- K to 3 reading specialist for next year
- Possible outdoor auction next year
- District is helping a lot this year but is a one time only - still need to raise money
- Vote on the budget tonight
- 24 out of 28 are Yes - Approved

Q & A

- Will the K-2 presentation be rescheduled - Teachers haven't agreed due to time constraints and may have to do it next year. There will be a Kinder info night
- Will middle school schedule change during the spring - Not at this time. Facilities will walk through to see how many more can fit in classrooms
- Can cohorts be mixed - We are investigating it
- Why are there two async days now for middle school - Kids are getting specific instruction 3 days a week from a teacher, it used to be 4 days of live instruction. This is the only way to accommodate in person and distance learners to fit in schedule
- Will there be changes now that it is 3 feet instead of 6 feet - Need to see how many can fit and if we can mix cohorts
