### PTO Meeting Summary Tuesday, November 9, 2021

#### Welcome and Introductions - Alex Dendy

- The PTO meeting started at 7:03 pm virtually via Zoom
- This will be the last PTO members meeting of 2021

#### District Wide Healthy Foods Committee - Jessica

- School district committee to improve the food menu in school
- Reducing processed foods and sugar - more scratch based cooking
- Just launched last month and have 50 parents involved so far
- Need more parents to help support
- Baker has said that our agenda will be picked up for their November meeting

- Taft, Hoover and Garfield don't have a PTA so if you know anyone one there, let them know. RCF may also be able to help
- Contractor run district - Sodexo. All food is premade and packaged with no flexibility
- A few years ago it switched from being district run to contractor ran
- Conscious kitchen - all organic food
- Looking at reducing food waste as well
- Teachers and staff are welcome on this committee

#### Direct Donations - Tanya Bachniak

- Campaign is technically over but still taking donations
- Giving Tuesday is coming up
- Promoting corporate matching
- We asked parents working for Google to consider donating their \$400 donation credit
- \$250,000 - 86% of our goal and includes corporate matching
- 27% from Corporate and 39% family participation
- If you haven't donated yet, it's not too late

#### Spring Play - Tiffany Gonzales

- Adelante and Clifford are planning plays already
- Schools are using Mustang Hall in San Carlos
- Possible dates Mar 25 - 27 but right before spring break or in May during State testing. May poll parents
- SCCT staff are fully vaccinated and have strict covid protocols. Masks required (mics under mask)
- Practices at school - masks would be required
- Thinking of doing Alice in Wonderland - need to look in storage to see what is there
- Other venues are quite expensive - email if you know of other venues
- 4 - 8 have parts in the play; K-3 part of the chorus/ensemble. If you sign up, there is a spot in the play
- There will be parent participation and a fee - will provide more info as we know

### **Budget - Leanna Staben**

- Anytime there is a change to the budget, we need to take a vote
- Last time it was created was April 2021, need to make some changes to it
- Dinner dance auction from 150K to 105K
- Counseling services was 44,306 - taking out since it is covered this year but won't be next year
- Fund-in-need from 2019 - change from 36K to 30K (adjusting as that was left from last school year)
- Language program for Middle school - taking out 6,500 since couldn't find spanish teacher
- Middle school planners / Thursday folders from 2,500 to 2,800 (prices increased due to covid)
- Music enrichment from 12K to 15K (now offering to 4th & 5th graders)
- Teacher / classroom stipend from 10K to 15K
- Carry over needs to increase from 100K to 145K
- Where there are dashes - need to be cautious as next year we will need to provide for them
- Not doing the fund in need this year as the need is the PTO
- Alex provided a poll to vote via Zoom - Approved

### **Questions**

- Will there be a book fair? - Yes, planning to do it in the spring and a family event
- Time of year to start planning for the first day of school packets? - Check with Diane and the teachers
- Are there opportunities for scholarships for enrichments? Some of the vendors provide it through homeschool. Nex year we will advertise that there are scholarships and help through the PTO
- There are a lot of great programs / no cost fundraisers - amazon smile, honey bear trees, shutterfly
