 - Roger is working to raise awareness on class size
 - School board seems to have barriers to having low class numbers

- Is there any update on 8th graders joining the Yosemite trip next year with the 7th graders since the current 7th grade didn't get to go this year
 - Charlene has it on the calendar to call and make a reservation for 7th and 8th graders next year and then we will see if it gets approved
 - Communication should come out soon
